

SAY **NO** TO CONSETT INCINERATOR

How to object and say **NO!** to Consett Incinerator

If you feel unable to write your own personal response but still want to object, a template standard letter is available - all you need to do is add the date, your full name and address including postcode, then *sign it*. You can then leave it in the hub, where we will collect it and forward it to the planning department at Durham County Council to be counted.

However, a personal objection does not need to be lengthy and time consuming. To make this process as easy as possible, all the information you need can be found in this quick guide. If you have no internet access, simply return it to the hub to be collected and we will send it electronically on your behalf.

QUICK GUIDE

1. You must include **your name, address** and 'Ref: **DM/20/03267/WAS Energy from Waste Facility at Hownsgill Industrial Estate**' in your correspondence to Durham County Council's planning department.
2. Tell them you object, and try to include some **material considerations** that will be taken into account, such as (but not limited to):
 - 👉 Highway safety
 - 👉 Traffic
 - 👉 Noise
 - 👉 Effect on listed building & conservation area
 - 👉 Design, appearance and materials
 - 👉 Government policy
 - 👉 Disabled persons' access
 - 👉 Proposals in the Development Plan
 - 👉 Nature conservation
3. **Send your objection** via one of the following options:
 - ⇒ Simply return your letter to the hub where you received the information and we will send it on your behalf.
 - ⇒ Email your objection to: planning@durham.gov.uk - Ref: DM/20/03267/WAS.
 - ⇒ Post objection in writing to: Regeneration, Economy & Growth, DCC, Planning Development (Strategic), Room 4/123-128, County Hall, Durham, DH1 5UL
